COGmas Diary 2024

- Week 1: 2nd-6th December: COGULOUS DISPLAYS & DECORATIONS get your classrooms, corridors and performance spaces ready for COGmas!
- Week 2: 9-13th December: COGTASTIC CLASSROOM CREATIONS get creative for COGmas with festive stories, drama, songs and more!
- Week 3: 16-20th December: YOUR BIG COGMAS SHOWCASE Share your COGmas creations in an end of term assembly or showcase of your choice.

The 3 WEEK DIARY can be used as a skeleton forward plan if you'd like to take part over the full 3 weeks, or feel free to pick and choose activities that work best for you.

- The longer term plan would be to work towards some kind of 'SHOWCASE' event in WEEK 3, such as:
 - An end of term assembly sharing Emotion Works COGmas creations or performances
 - o A communal or class-based parent event
 - Create a photo slideshow or video tour of COGmas work to share with other classes and parents
 - A large COGmas art display
 - A song performance a COGmas composition, or a piece of work unpacking an emotional song lyric
 - A festive drama, animation, story or piece of poetry relating to the Cogs or Cog language
 - o A COGmas party game you've thought up
- In WEEK 2 we'll help you with lots more ideas for your COGmas creations providing examples of Emotion Works lessons linked to festive literature, songs, adverts, games, drama ideas and artwork in case you get stuck coming up with your own idea.
- But first, WEEK 1 is about getting prepared.
 - You'll find our festive COGmas resources & the weekly activity ideas on the <u>Cogmas 2024 Web Page</u>
 - If you're relatively new to Emotion Works, make sure your pupils are familiar with the first 5 cogs (Primary ages / ASN equivalent) or have a discussion about the COGmas characters using our 'foundation language' suggestions (Early Years / ASN equivalent).
 - The activity ideas for Week 1 encourage you to explore the cog concepts and language through art & craft activities while also helping to decorate your classrooms, corridors and performance spaces in preparation for your live sharing event or recording & capturing of COGmas work
