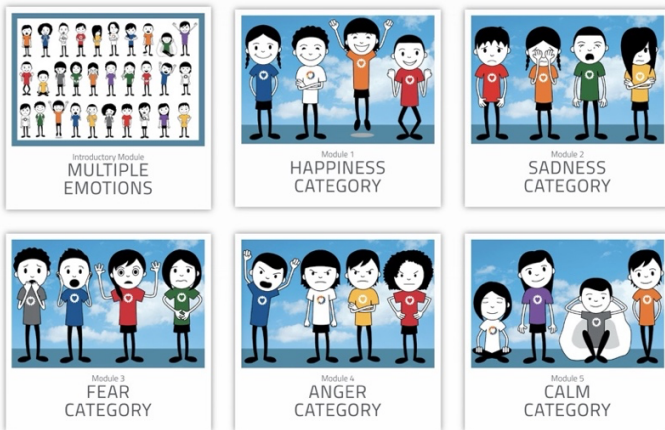
1-EMOTION-AT-A-TIME & LITERACY PLANNING

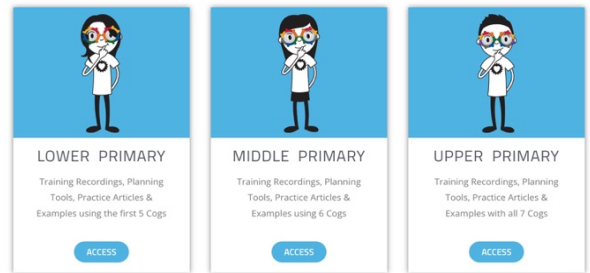
1. Delivering a new roll-out using a '1-Emotion-at-a-Time' / 'Emotion focused' approach
2. Exploring and trying out a wide variety of Literacy lesson examples to build
3. Planning and delivering your first lessons using ours or your own Literacy planning tools
